Video Tips

1. Consider your location for filming. You will ideally want a quiet room with plenty of light.
2. Think about background footage you can add. Perhaps film in conjunction with an event.

4. Use an agreement when sharing your final video to ensure proper use. We've included a template in the Member Portal you are welcome to use.
